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Senator Siewert asked:

- a) Provide the criteria/tender documents for the evaluation?
- b) Who is on the advisory panel?

Answer:

- a) The Department is undertaking a comprehensive evaluation of the Mental Health Nurse Incentive Program (MHNIP) which will consider the appropriateness, effectiveness and impact of the program in meeting its core objectives of:
 - improving the level of care for people with severe and persistent mental illnesses;
 - reducing likelihood of unnecessary hospital admissions and readmissions for people with severe and persistent mental illnesses; and
 - assisting people with severe and persistent mental illnesses in keeping well and feeling connected within the community.

In addition to evaluating patient outcomes, the evaluation will also include program take up, demand profile, costs benefits and program structure and compliance.

The Department is currently assessing submissions received from individuals/organisations to conduct the evaluation work. Once a successful individual/organisation has been engaged for this task, Request for Quotation documents can be made available on request.
