OUTCOME 3: Access to Medical Services

Topic: VALUE TO THE TAXPAYER

Written Question on Notice

Senator Back asked:

- a) What is the total amount recouped from doctors in the last two financial years?
- b) As a trend has this figure been increasing?

Answer:

- a) The total amount of repayment orders made by Professional Services Review (PSR) for the last two financial years is \$6.88 million.
- b) Over the last five financial years PSR has made repayment orders totalling \$11,627,816.00. As a trend this repayment figure has remained relatively static over the past five years, with the exception of 2009-10 which saw a significant increase in completed matters.

A summary of the outcomes over the five year period is provided in the table below.

Please note that a practitioner may receive both a full disqualification and partial disqualification. For example a Practitioner may be fully disqualified from Medicare for a specified period, and partially disqualified from access to specific item numbers for a further, extended period.
