Senator Fierravanti-Wells asked:

- a) What is the status of the limitation of the targets for elective surgery access?
- b) What are the statistics in relation to elective surgery?

Answer:

- a) The Expert Panel working on the National Partnership Agreement on Improving Public Hospital Services (NPA) considered the targets for elective surgery access and reported to COAG on 30 June 2011.
