Senator Ludwig asked:

- 1. List the current inventory of computers owned, leased, stored, or able to be accessed by the Department, listing the equipment cost and location
- 2. Please detail the operating systems used by the Departments computers, the contractual arrangements for operating software and the on-going costs

Answer:

- 1. SBS lease computers over a three year period. The current inventory includes 1,133 PC's, 423 laptops and 1,775 monitors. Average unit prices: PC's \$1,462; Laptops \$1,942; Monitors \$288. Locations: Sydney 2,857; Melbourne 433; Remote offices (Canberra, Adelaide, Brisbane, Perth) 41.
- 2. Operating Systems: Microsoft Windows (XP, 7, 8); Apple OS (X). Microsoft Windows operating systems are part of an Enterprise Agreement with Microsoft. The cost of the agreement to SBS over the current 3 year period is \$1,470,000. The Apple operating system is incorporated into the cost of the hardware.
