4. If so, where were these purchased
5. If so, list the process for identifying how they would be purchased
6. If so, what is the current location for these items?
7. If so, what is the current stocking level for each of these items?

**Answer:**

1. Yes, one wine fridge was purchased.
2. \$1,176.36.
3. \$1,176.36.
4. The Good Guys Discount Warehouse (Nunawading).
5. The item was purchased via open procurement.

7. The wine fridge currently contains ten bottles of wine consisting five bottles of sparkling and five bottles of white wine.
