**Senator LUD LAM**—I am also interested to know whether the Commonwealth has any idea—because there is nothing on the public record that I am aware of—about the greenhouse gas consequences of the Greater Sunrise project in the Territory. As at March 2011, a development option for the Greater Sunrise fields has not been approved and is the subject of ongoing discussions between Australia, Timor-Leste and the Sunrise Joint Venture; it is therefore too early to forecast greenhouse gas emissions levels resulting from the production of Sunrise gas.
