**ANSWER**

1. The Department owns 14 vehicles as at 28 February 2014.

3. Vehicles are used for the transportation of equipment for field work, the collection of goods and for travel to remote locations.

# These vehicles have been under repair for the period in question.

6. The Department leases 155 vehicles as at 28 February 2014.
7. The Department's leased vehicles are located in each State and Territory in Australia.
8. The Department's fleet consists of 75 National Trade Measurement vehicles and 36 pool vehicles which are used for the transportation of equipment for field work, the collection and delivery of goods and for travel to remote locations. In addition there are 18 AusIndustry Regional Manager vehicles and 26 Executive Scheme Vehicles (SES officers).
- 9 and 10. The total cost of the 155 leased vehicles from 1 December 2013 to 28 February 2014 was \$554,316 and the total kilometres travelled were 495,890 kilometres. To provide this data on an individual vehicle basis would be a significant diversion of departmental and agency resources.
