STATEMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION 7(3) OF THE AUSTRALIAN NUCLEAR SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY ORGANISATION ACT 1987

On 14 August 2012, the Australian Nuclear Science and Technology Organisation (ANSTO) participated in the formation of a company, Synchrotron Light Source Australia Pty Ltd and subscribed to be the sole shareholder in that company.

Synchrotron Light Source Australia Pty Ltd is a special purpose company formed to efficiently and effectively operate the Australian Synchrotron as a national synchrotron facility, facilitating the performance of scientific, medical and industrial research, and to promote and/or advance scientific knowledge, particularly in relation to synchrotron science, through the facilitation of scientific research and the development of innovation and technology.

Synchrotron Light Source Australia Pty Ltd will operate the Australian Synchrotron, utilising funding from the Commonwealth, the State of Victoria, the New Zealand Synchrotron Group and the Australian university sector.
