#### **Question:**

#### Answer:

Please see attached tables for information on DSP recipients as at June 2004 by:

- age and gender;
- medical condition;
- employment status (earners vs non-earners) and ranged income from employment\*; and
- statistical local area.

#### Notes:

The information on income from employment is from a different source with slightly different business rules and so the total population is different.

Due to confidentiality provision cells with less than 20 recipients have been replaced with '<20'. This includes cells that have a value of zero. If the total column makes it possible to work out the value of any '<20' cells, the total field has been left blank.

<sup>\*</sup> Information on non-employment income is not available.

Data by SLA is based on concording postcode data into 2001 ABS SLA groupings. It excludes DSP recipients with invalid postcodes and there is a small residual error due to rounding.
