**NEW DISABILITY EMPLOYMENT SERVICES PROVIDERS**

The Minister claims that 'The NDRC aims to create at least 1000 jobs each financial year' a) Where does the Minister anticipate these new job opportunities will be found? b) Will the NDRC keep accurate records on the "new job opportunities" that it creates each financial year to enable an independent audit to be undertaken to compare the Minister's claims with the actual job creations?

**Answer**

The quotation is from the DEEWR produced Fact Sheet on the National Disability Recruitment Coordinator (NDRC).

- a) The job opportunities will be created across Australia, in all states and territories.
- b) Performance reporting is required by the NDRC service provider. The NDRC service provider is required to report all vacancies to the Department who will publish the vacancies on the Department's secure website so they can be accessed by all Disability Employment Services providers.
