## Question: The Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Education Action Plan

Update on number of Focus Schools (state and region) and total population of those schools.

#### Answer

- All Australian Education Ministers agreed under the *Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Education Action Plan (2010-2014)* (the Education Action Plan) to identify a key group of schools called Focus Schools.

- There are currently 906 Focus Schools.
