#### Question

## **Job Capacity Assessment issues**

In the year 2010-11 and from 1 July to 31 December 2011, how many Job Capacity Assessments were conducted over the telephone, or on the papers alone?

## **Answer**

As at 1 July 2011, Department of Human Services became the sole service provider for assessment services.

DEEWR has policy responsibility for assessments related to employment services eligibility; these are known as Employment Services Assessments (ESAt).

Department of Families, Housing, Community Services and Indigenous Affairs has policy responsibility for assessments related to the Disability Support Pension; these are known as Job Capacity Assessments (JCA).

The data in this response does not include assessments related to the Disability Support Pension.
