Senator RONALDSON: Did Mr Williams make any recommendations in those early stages or give in that memorandum any indication of his view on the matter? Ms O'Neill: I cannot answer that for the same reason. Senator RONALDSON: I am not asking what he said, I am asking whether indeed that is what was in the memorandum. Ms O'Neill: I will take that on notice.

Answer

Fair Work Australia has provided the following response:

The memo sets out Mr Williams' views about the next actions required in the two HSU inquiries as at the date of the memo. The memo therefore contains information about an investigation that has not yet concluded. As the investigation has not concluded, there is a substantial prospect of inflicting prejudice on the investigation, and any subsequent proceedings, by revealing further detail of the content of the memo.
