- 3. Yes, the report was made public on 13 April 2014.
- 4. The reviewers consulted with the sector prior to drafting the report. They received 84 submissions from a range of stakeholders and also held consultative meetings with some stakeholders in December 2013 and January 2014.
- 5. The Government responded to the recommendations of the Review of the Demand Driven System in the 2014-15 Budget.
- 6. Yes.
- 7. The Hon Dr David Kemp and Mr Andrew Norton worked on the review for a total of 20 days and 66 days respectively.
- 8. At the time of the February 2014 Senate Estimates only two staff were working on the Review. This was taking up approximately 80 per cent of the time of one EL1 and 10 per cent of the time of one EL2.
