DEPARTMENT

Following Machinery of Government changes on 18 September 2013, the new Department of Education was created.

As at 24 March 2014, no costs have been incurred in relation to rebranding for logos, consultancy, office configuration, signage or letterhead (templates are made available online through the department's intranet and letters are only printed as needed). New business cards have been printed at a cost of \$2711.75. New name badges have been printed at a cost of \$3134.80. The separation of Education related website content away from its predecessor Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations was performed in-house, within existing departmental resources.
