Senator O'NEILL: In terms of meeting the goals that they set and reporting on that, do you have any statistics on the success of the program? Ms Hanlon: Each of the states and territories provided their own reports that responded to the various milestones that they had set, so we would have to take that on notice also if you wanted to have a comprehensive report of state and territory achievement against those milestones.

Answer

Under the Low SES School Communities National Partnership, states and territories are required to report against agreed milestones in annual and progress reports submitted in April and October each year.
