50+ years	Job search requirements will be aligned with those for prime age NSA recipients.			
	No annual Mutual Obligation activity requirement, but eligible to participate in Work for the Dole on a voluntary basis.			
55-64 years	Activity test requirements apply unless participating in voluntary work or employment for 15 hours or more per week.			
50-54 years	No longer able to satisfy activity test by undertaking voluntary work or a combination of voluntary and part time work.			
40-49 years	Unless another Mutual Obligation activity is commenced, Work for the Dole is the default activity.
