Senator Crossin provided in writing:

CDEP Coordination and administration has been very difficult in the past due to heavy demands in liaison with Centrelink, the demands of reporting to ATSIS, myriad of purchases needing adherence to procurement requirements etc. Simplification would be of potential great benefit in assisting real activities to improve, but how do you think simplification is possible – many remote CDEP's already work with fairly minimal staffing, and in the past departments have been unwilling to reduce their requirements?
