Question

Job Capacity Assessments

How many Job Capacity Assessments does the department expect will be undertaken in 2009–10 and 2010–11?

Answer

It is expected that approximately 464 000 Job Capacity Assessments will be conducted in 2009–10. In March 2010 improved arrangements are being introduced to ensure multiple assessments of an individual will occur only when required to meet their needs, and around 409 000 Job Capacity Assessments are expected to be conducted during 2010–11.
