**Trade Training Centres - Qualifications/Certificates**

Senator CORMANN—Can you match them with the schools? I want to know, per school, what the new qualifications are that were not being delivered at that school before which have only started to come into play since the trades training centre became fully operational. Last time we spoke.....

We will probably have to go to the schools and I think it will be really useful because the point about getting modern twenty-first century facilities for these vocational training courses is that you have to have facilities of that quality to offer the high level qualifications. **Answer**

Trade Training Centres have been developed to ensure that students undertaking vocational training can do so in modern facilities with equipment suited to the field of training. Most of the qualifications being delivered in Trade Training Centres can be considered as new qualifications because they are being delivered in new industry-standard learning environments.
