**Review of HSR Training Course Accreditation Program**

**Issues**

We suggest that you **endorse**:

- The Guidelines - Health and Safety Representatives (HSR) Training in the Commonwealth Jurisdiction.

**Background**

- The Commission has conducted a review of the *HSR Training Course Accreditation Program* (the Program) and modified the Program accordingly.
- The Commission has also revised the *Guidelines for Accreditation of Occupational Health and Safety training courses for Health and Safety Representatives under the Occupational Health and Safety Act* (the Guidelines). These are the official instructions regarding its expectations for training provided and accredited under section 27 of the Act.
- These do not impose any new requirements on the providers of HSR accredited training or for training courses accredited but do clarify the expected learning outcomes. The Guidelines are largely consistent with requirements imposed by other jurisdictions.
