Senator NASH: How do you define the tier 1 eligibility? Ms Stanion: I will need to take that on notice.

**Answer**

The Inclusion and Professional Support Program Guidelines state that Family Day Care and In Home educators caring for an eligible child or children may be approved for Tier One Inclusion Support Subsidy, where the educator is required to provide mild to moderate assistance to support the child's social, communication, health and physical needs and supervise any challenging behaviours that are a function of the ongoing high support needs of the child.
