Question

BER - P21 forecast completion dates

Senator MASON: That would be delightful. The next question is a very obvious one: can we ever expect them to be finished, or is this the Great Wall of China? Ms Smith: I have expected completion dates for all of the remaining 31 projects and can give you details of those if you would like. Senator MASON: Is that for all 31 as a group or individually? Ms Smith: I have them by the education sector. There is one project in the ACT—the Aranda Steiner school— Senator MASON: Let me just get my pen. Ms Paul: I presume these are estimates received from the authorities. Ms Smith: The relevant authorities, yes. Senator MASON: So this is not a time table but an aspiration, is it? Ms Paul: I think this is an estimate by an education authority. Senator MASON: Not again! Ms Paul: Not our estimates. Senator MASON: Not yours; all right. Ms Smith: As Ms Paul has said, they are forecast completion dates. Broadly by guarter, we have nine of the 31 expected to be completed by the end of this month, four by September 2013—they are all this year with the exception of four— Senator MASON: Are you sure? That is very— Ms Smith: 14 by December 2013 and a further four by the first guarter in 2014. As Ms Paul said, these are projects that have been managed by education authorities, grant authorities or state governments. They provide us with their scheduling. There are a range of factors as to why some of the scheduling varies. There might be a re-scoping of the project or a new architect brought on. There are a range of reasons. I actually have reasons attached to all of the remaining 31 projects, if you are interested. Senator MASON: After several years of this, forgive me but I am beyond interest at this stage. Although, I am sure the committee has no problem with you giving that information to the committee. That would probably be the fair thing to do. Ms Paul: Presumably, these are the reasons given to us by the relevant education authorities. Senator MASON: Perhaps we do not need to read it into the transcript at this stage. Ms Smith. That might be a little bit indulgent. Giving it to us on notice is fine, Ms Paul. If there is a written document that you can lay your hands on, that would be fine. Ms Paul: We will take that on notice. Ms Smith: If I may, I would like to say that all of the projects—the remaining 31—have commenced. They are all under way. I just need to let you know that, as well. Senator MASON: Thank God for small mercies, Ms Smith! Have any of the forecast completion dates mentioned previously been changed? Have we had any further blow-outs in completion dates, Ms Smith? Ms Smith: There have been some that have changed for the sorts of reasons that I mentioned. I will give you an example. The Tongala Primary School, is a round-3 project which has been delayed. It was one of those that we originally thought were completing in April, but it was forecast to have been completed two months later. Senator MASON: So there is a range? Ms Smith: That is the nature of the sorts of details that I have on each of these 31 projects. Senator MASON: So, some time, by

the end of the first quarter next year, they may all be finished? We should have a little party to celebrate, Ms Smith! I suspect it will be a big day when they are all finished. You will let me know when they are finished, will you not? Ms Smith: I am sure that we will let the committee know; yes.

Answer

As at 11 July 2013 there are 28 projects yet to complete under the *Primary Schools* for the 21st Century (P21) element of the Building the Education Revolution program. Education Authorities have advised DEEWR of the following reasons for the delay in the completion of these projects.
