(2) Yr 11 and 12 student numbers in VET in Schools programme by location

The large majority of schools across Australia (over 95% of all schools offering senior secondary curriculum) deliver VET in Schools programmes. However, information about VET delivery in specific schools in the listed areas is not collected nationally.

The national data on VET in Schools is collected through MCEETYA processes and the published data is aggregated at the state and territory level.
