#### **Question:**

Senator Wong asked in writing: <u>Employment Entry Payment</u>. How many claims have been made in each of the past three years at each rate and what is the total cost? How does that compare in each year with budget estimates (at each rate)?

#### Answer:

A separate claim for Employment Entry Payment (EEP) is not required.

EEP payments are not appropriated separately; they are reported against administered dollars for income support payments. The number of EEP payments made for the past three financial years were: 2003-04: 85,280 2004-05: 119,107

2004-05: 119,107 2005-06: 116,231

Separate Budget estimates are not prepared for EEP payments. It is therefore not possible to compare actual outcomes with budget estimates.
