#### **Ouestion:**

Senator Wong asked in writing: How many applications have been received in relation to this Scheme? Of those, how many have been approved, rejected, pending determination? Of those rejected, on what grounds was the application rejected?

#### **Answer:**

As at 31 October 2006, 35 applications had been received and processed in relation to the Unlawful Termination Assistance Scheme. Twenty four were approved and 11 were deemed ineligible.
