### **Question:**

Senator Wong asked in writing: <u>Work Choices Implementation Agencies - National</u> <u>Adviser Network Programme</u>. How is this programme run? Who provides the information? Was it put to tender? When? When do the current contracts end?

### Answer:

A network of the state and territory Chambers of Commerce and Industry, were selected in an open tender process to develop and deliver services under the National Adviser Network Programme. The tender was advertised on 17 June 2006 and the contract for service delivery was signed on 13 October 2006. The contract ends on 30 June 2007.

**Estimated cost:** Based on the FOI calculator it has taken approximately 2 hours at an estimated cost of \$40 to prepare this answer.
