Senator Wong asked in writing: <u>Work Choices Implementation Agencies - National</u> <u>Adviser Network Programme</u>. What is the cost of this programme? Please provide a breakdown of costs per provider, per state etc

#### Answer:

The total cost of the National Adviser Network Programme contract is \$3.2 million (GST inclusive). This amount is payable in its entirety to the Chamber of Commerce and Industry (Western Australia), which is coordinating a network of state and territory Chambers of Commerce and Industry to deliver the programme.
