#### **Ouestion:**

Senator Wong asked in writing: <u>Utilities Allowance</u>. How much will be paid per person in this financial year?

#### **Answer:**

Payments of Utilities Allowance (UA) are made in March and September each year. The rate of UA is indexed to CPI. The current rate of UA is:

- Single: \$105.20 annually (two payments of \$52.60)
- Partnered each eligible partner: \$52.60 annually (two payments of \$26.30)
- Partnered illness separated couple, respite care couple or partner imprisoned: \$105.20 (two payments of \$52.60)
