Senator Wong asked at *Hansard* page 75: In relation to W016-06 and W017-06, can the Department provide disaggregated figures, of transition group plus new applicants.

Answer:

W017-06 – No. This answer relates to Parenting Payment, while the transition group only relates to Disability Support Pension (DSP).

W016-06 – This answer provided May 2005 estimates of the number of people likely to go on Newstart Allowance rather than DSP using an annual average cumulative methodology. These estimates have not been revised.

Subsequent estimates used DSP customer flow numbers, which were adjusted at the 2005-06 Additional Estimates. The estimated numbers being granted Newstart Allowance as an alternative to DSP are as follows (rounded to nearest 100):
