## Humanitarian Entrants – English Language Skills Program

How many humanitarian entrants are going into workplaces not having completed the English language skills program?

## **Answer**

The Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations offers three English language programs, the Language, Literacy and Numeracy Program (LLNP), the English as a Second Language - New Arrivals (ESL-NA) Program and the Workplace English Language and Literacy (WELL) program. These programs do not capture the migration arrangement a person entered Australia under.
