#### Question

### YOUTH ALLOWANCE

What is the evidence that young people have lower costs of living than other groups in the community?

#### **Answer**

Costs of living are influenced by a wide range of personal choices and living circumstances – that is, geography, household composition, relationships and family circumstances, and work and study arrangements.

Youth cost of living is generally lower than other population groups for a range of reasons:

- youth are more likely to be single adults without dependents
- youth are less likely to be servicing high housing costs because they are more likely to be living in the parental home or in a group house on a rental and cost-share basis
- youth are healthier overall and therefore have lower health related expenses
- youth are more likely to live at home with financial support provided by carers and parents.
