I will have to check whether we have the average in the room with us tonight. The number for 2010-11 was 841,000 families benefiting from the childcare rebate. Senator BACK: And you can take the other figure for us on notice.

    The number of families using approved child care in 2010-11 was 841,000 . Of these, the number of families who received Child Care Benefit was 644,000 . The average Child Care Benefit payment per family for the 2010-11 financial year was $\$ 3,269$.
