Question

Student Resilience and Wellbeing

What programmes are now being funded under this initiative and what organisations have been engaged to deliver them?

Answer

In 2013 the Student Resilience and Wellbeing Program is funding:

- Flinders University <u>Australian Research Council Linkage Project Are the</u> <u>Kids alright? Understanding the wellbeing of Australian children in their</u> <u>middle years</u>. This survey is part of the Social and Emotional Development of children aged 8 to 14 years measure (\$1.5 million over 5 years).
- **Together for Humanity Foundation Limited** Funding of \$1.036 million over 2009-10 to 2012-13 to facilitate workshops and provide resources that support teachers and students in learning about diversity.
- Australian Research Alliance for Children and Youth (ARACY) Limited -Funding of \$1.1 million for ARACY operations for 2011-12 to 2013-14.
- Australian Teenage Expo 30 August to 1 September 2012 one-off funding of \$30,000 to support the attendance of not-for-profit organisations to participate in the Expo to provide young people, parents and educators with information on how they can assist with issues affecting young Australians.
- National Anti-bullying Forum 31 July 2012 <u>How schools and parents can</u> <u>work together to address bullying</u>. Funding of \$14,400 to cover forum participant costs.
