## Repayment threshold for HECS-HELP

- a. What is the current repayment threshold for HECS-HELP debts?
- b. How is this threshold set?
- c. What work has the Department done or commissioned on the appropriateness of the threshold?
- d. what work has the Department performed or commissioned on alternative repayment thresholds?
- e. What communication has the Department had with the Commission of Audit on HECS and HELP debts?
- g. What communication has the Department had with the Commission of Audit regarding graduate outcomes, including graduate salaries?

#### **Answer**

a. HELP repayment rates for the 2013-14 income year are as follows:
