#### Question

## Office for Learning and Teaching

For the Office for Learning and Teaching please provide:

- a. the 2012-13 updated budget outcome for the Office for Learning and Teaching, and for all the programs it administers
- b. Current forward estimates for 2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17
- c. What the breakdown of these estimates is between administered and Departmental/OLT costs?
- d. Please provide an update on the status of all of your grants programs, including when the schedule for opening, closing, announcing and contracting grants projects. This should include information on commissioned projects
- e. What regulatory roles does the Office for Learning and Teaching currently perform.
- f. How has the OLT's workload and responsibilities changed since the publication of the Review of Higher Education regulation?

#### Answer

- a. The updated budget outcome for the Promotion of Excellence in Learning and Teaching in Higher Education (PELTHE) programme in 2012–13 is \$12 863 246. The Enhancing the Training of Mathematics and Science Teachers (ETMST) programme commenced 2013–2014.
- b. Current forward estimates as per the Pre-election Economic and Fiscal Outlook (PEFO) for 2013–14 to 2016–17 for PELTHE are represented in Table 1.

- c. The figures in Table 1 and Table 2 are forward estimates for administered costs only. There is no departmental funding in PELTHE or ETMST.
- d. The Office for Learning and Teaching (OLT) has 238 active grant projects including commissioned work.
