Question

Staffing Cessations

a) How many ongoing staff left the department/agency from 7 September 2013 to date? What classification were these staff? b) How many non-ongoing staff left department/agency from 7 September 2013 to date? What classification were these staff?

Answer

As a result of changes made to the Administrative Arrangements Orders on 18 September 2013, the answer to this question is in two parts:

1. For the period 7 September to 17 September 2013 the answer refers to the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations (DEEWR).

2. For the period 18 September to 30 November 2013 the answer refers to the Department of Education.

7 September to 17 September 2013

For the period 7 September to 17 September 2013, 11 employees left DEEWR. Of these separations nine were ongoing employees and two were non-ongoing employees.

Employee numbers will vary in future as MoG changes are settled across the four affected departments.
