#### Question

### **Printing**

- a) How many documents (include the amount of copies) have been printed from 7 September 2013 to date?
- b) How many of these printed documents were also published online?

### **Answer**

As a result of changes made to the Administrative Arrangements Orders on 18 September 2013, the answer to this question is in two parts:

- 1. For the period 7 September to 17 September 2013 the answer refers to the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations.
- 2. For the period 18 September to 30 November 2013 the answer refers to the Department of Education.

For the purposes of this answer, a document is defined as bound booklets and reports (such as annual reports) that have been publicly released; or other documents such as fact sheets and brochures that have been publicly released.

a) Bound booklets and reports (such as annual reports) that have been publicly released

One document was produced which was published on-line without being printed.

b) Other documents such as fact sheets and brochures that have been publicly released

No documents produced.

# Part 2 – 18 September to 30 November - (answer refers to Department of Education documents)

a) Bound booklets and reports (such as annual reports) that have been publicly released

Two documents were produced, one was published on-line without being printed and one was printed (600 copies) but not published on-line.

b) Other documents such as fact sheets and brochures that have been publicly released

One document was produced which was printed (200 copies) but not published online
