Question

Stationery

How much was spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers/Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio from 7 September 2013 to date?

Answer

As a result of changes made to the Administrative Arrangements Orders on 18 September 2013, the answer to this question is in two parts:

1. For the period 7 September to 17 September 2013 the answer refers to the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations and portfolio agencies.
2. For the period 18 September to 4 December 2013 the answer refers to the Department of Education and portfolio agencies.

7 September to 17 September 2013

The department and its agencies did not incur any expenditure for Ministers'/Parliamentary Secretary's stationery requirements during the period 7 September to 17 September 2013.

18 September to 4 December 2013

The department spent a total of \$11,647.61 on Ministers' and Parliamentary Secretary's stationery requirements.

The Australian Research Council spent a total of \$270 on the Minister's stationery requirements.

The remaining Education portfolio agencies did not incur any expenditure for their Ministers' or Parliamentary Secretary's stationery requirements.
