Question

Student numbers - Victorian schools

Can you please indicate in 2013 how many primary school students there are in regional Victoria (outside of metropolitan Melbourne) enrolled in a) public schools and b) private schools? Can you please indicate how many children in regional Victoria are enrolled in kindergarten programs in 2013? And in 2014? Can you please indicate in 2013 how many children in regional Victoria are enrolled in high school in a) public schools and b) private schools For each of the abovementioned requests, can you please provide a comparison of Victoria's student numbers to the other states?

Answer

Data are not available for 2013.

Data on 2013 kindergarten (i.e. year before full-time school) enrolments will not be available until March 2014, as part of the annual National Early Childhood Education and Care Collection and will be released at that time.

Data on 2014 kindergarten (i.e. year before full-time school) enrolments will not be available until March 2015, as part of the annual National Early Childhood Education and Care Collection and will be released at that time.

With regard to comparative data on 2013 and 2014 kindergarten (i.e. year before full-time school) enrolments, data will not be available until March 2014 and March 2015 respectively, as part of the annual National Early Childhood Education and Care Collection released at those times.
