On 22 March 2013, Parkville Global Avisory (PGA) was contracted to undertake an independent evaluation of the National Partnership on Literacy and Numeracy (LNNP) and the National Partnership for Low Socio-Economic Status School Communities (LSES NP).

A national evaluation framework has been established and agreed by all states and territories.

The final report is anticipated to be completed by early 2014 for consideration by Government.

2. What is the progress of the evaluation work the Department has been doing with regard to the National Partnership for Low Socio-Economic Status School Communities?
