**Question**

**Building the Education Revolution (BER) – signs and plaques**

Senator RUSTON: Just a small matter: signs and plaques. How much was spent on signage for these projects? That is, plaques for building and signs to say that this was a BER project—et cetera. Ms Paul: The largest signs were the corflute signs that were inside school premises but on the boundary usually. That would be a considerable expenditure, but I imagine we are going to have to take on notice because this spend would have been several years ago or a couple of years ago anyway. We might take that on notice and get that to you.

**Answer**

Total expenditure on Building the Education Revolution signs and plaques was \$1 849 950.
