#### Question

##### Creative Young Stars – breakdown by electorates

Senator O'NEILL: To a program much closer to my own heart, thankfully: the Creative Young Stars program. How many individuals have benefited from this program so far? Mr Cook: I will ask Ms Hanlon to answer that. Senator O'NEILL: Ms Hanlon, you get to administer this one, do you? Ms Hanlon: Yes. Senator O'NEILL: I can tell you there are very many happy young people on the Central Coast who have benefited from this program. Ms Hanlon: It is a very happy program, I think. A total of \$841,000 was awarded in the first round. There were a total of 964 successful applicants in that round. pg 93 Senator O'NEILL: Across how many electorates? Ms Hanlon: Most electorates awarded some grants. There was a combination of individual grants and group grants for the program. To give you a breakdown by electorate, I would have to take that on notice. Senator O'NEILL: That would be great, by electorate and state.

#### Answer

Under Round One of the Creative Young Stars programme, 144 group grants and 818 individual grants were awarded to successful applicants, which is a total of 962 grants. The total number of grants has reduced from 964 as two applicants chose to withdraw their applications and repay their grants to the Department of Education.
