Question

Printing

How many documents (include the amount of copies) have been printed from 7 September 2013 to date? How many of these printed documents were also published online?

Answer

As a result of changes made to the Administrative Arrangements Orders on 18 September 2013, the answer to this question is in two parts:

- 1. For the period 7 September to 17 September 2013 the answer refers to the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations.*
- 2. For the period 18 September to 30 November 2013 the answer refers to the Department of Employment.*

For the purposes of this answer, a document is defined as bound booklets and reports (such as annual reports) that have been publicly released; or other documents such as fact sheets and brochures that have been publicly released.

Part 1 - 7 September to 17 September 2013 - (answer refers to DEEWR documents)

'Documents' fall into two categories:

A. Bound booklets and reports (such as annual reports) that have been publicly released

- One document was produced which was published on-line without being printed.

B. Other documents such as fact sheets and brochures that have been publicly released

- No documents produced.

Part 2 – 18 September to 30 November - (answer refers to Department of Employment documents)

'Documents' fall into two categories:

A. Bound booklets and reports (such as annual reports) that have been publicly released

- Three documents were produced, two were published on-line without being printed and one was printed (500 copies) and published on-line.

B. Other documents such as fact sheets and brochures that have been publicly released

- Two documents were produced, one was published on-line without being printed and one was printed (200 copies), but not published on-line.
