Question

Partial work capacity job seekers obtaining employment

For the year to September 2012 (or similar period) please indicate the proportion of people with partial work capacity in the JSA programs who obtained full and part time employment 3 months after participating in the program.

Answer

The table below outlines proportion of job seekers in Job Services Australia with a partial capacity to work who achieved a three month employment outcome in the year ending September 2012.

Full-time	Part-time	Total
8.6	24.5	33.2

Note: A job seeker is considered to have a partial capacity to work if they have an impairment that prevents them from working at least 30 hours per work.
