- * For West Metro, a net project payment of \$10.9 million has been reflected in total commitments (\$91m originally committed less \$80.1m returned due to cancellation of the project = \$10.9m).
- **The National Broadband Network commitment for equity payments and the regional backbone blackspots program from the Building Australia Fund is fixed at \$2,400 million. The commitment relating to public debt interest on Aussie Infrastructure Bonds is sensitive to movements in interest rates and the timing of the infrastructure bonds being issued.
