Where a service was provided at any location other than the department or agency's own premises, please provide:

- a) The location used
- b) The number of employees who took part on each occasion
- c) The total number of hours involved for all employees who took part
- d) Any costs the department or agency's incurred to use the location

Answer:

- a) The Australian Public Service Commission (APSC) provided the training; two offsite locations were used by the APSC as venues:
 - Tuggeranong Homestead, Tuggeranong
 - The Members' Dining Hall at Old Parliament House, Parkes.
- b) There were two employees who attended the APSC for training.
- c) The total number of hours spent on offsite training was 38.5 hours.
- d) The Department of Regional Australia, Regional Development and Local Government was not required to pay for the cost of the training location.
