1. What is the current staffing profile of the department/agency?
2. Provide a list of staffing numbers, broken down by classification level, division, home base location (including town/city and state)

**Answer**

1. 825 employees (headcount) at 4 June 2014. There were:

- 705 ongoing employees; and
- 120 non-ongoing employees.

The workforce comprises of 607 full-time employees; 83 part-time employees; 56 sessional employees; and 79 casual employees. The average age of the workforce is 46 years.

2. All staff are all located in Parliament House, Canberra. A breakdown of these staffing numbers by classification/division are in the table below:
