1. Taxi expenses from Budget Estimates in February 2014 to date totaled \$10,880.30 (ex GST).

Breakdown for each business group-

2. Taxi costs are incurred for travel:

- to and from Canberra Airport when travelling on official business:
- to and from a destination airport to an official business venue or official business accommodation;
- to and from official accommodation to a venue (if accommodation is not reasonably close to the venue);
- to official activities (local and interstate) when transporting support equipment (e.g. broadcasting recording equipment, projectors, personal computers, etc.) where taxi travel is the most cost-effective method;
- between Parliament House and a local venue where the employee is required to attend an official meeting or other official business; or
- when the employee is "on call" and may be required to return to Parliament House outside of normal office hours.
