## REPORT TO FINANCE AND PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION LEGISLATION COMMITTEE – OCTOBER ESTIMATES 2010

#### TRENDS DURING THE 42<sup>ND</sup> PARLIAMENT

The attached statistics and tables show trends and comparisons in the activities of Senate committees during the 42<sup>nd</sup> parliament:

### During the 42<sup>nd</sup> Parliament:

- There was an increase in the total number of references to committees, from 234 in the 41<sup>st</sup> parliament to 309 in the 42nd parliament (this does not include matters re-referred to committees at the beginning of parliaments).
- The busiest committees at any one time were Economics (maximum of 14 references at one time), Community Affairs (maximum of 14 references at one time) and Legal and Constitutional Affairs (maximum of 7 references at one time).
- This increase in activity is also reflected in the total number of committee reports tabled rising from 396 in the 41<sup>st</sup> parliament to 493 in the 42nd parliament.
- In 2010 alone, the Economics Committees tabled 25 reports, the Legal and Constitutional Committees tabled 25 reports and the Environment and Communications Committees tabled 20 reports.
- Currently, three select committees administered by the Senate are in operation.


The committee office FTE staffing level as at September 2010 is 58.2, slightly less than at the peak of activity during 2009 when it was 62, but still close to the levels of staffing and committee activity experienced in 2003–04.

A variety of workload management strategies have been used in the Senate committee office to meet the significant increase in workload in the 42<sup>nd</sup> parliament:

- Committee secretariats which are less busy frequently provide research, analysis and administrative assistance to committee secretariats with large numbers of references and those with very short reporting deadlines;
- Officers from other areas of the Department have undertaken additional duties to assist committee secretariats;
- Committee staff have been asked to work (in some cases, significant amounts of) additional hours.





